INTERNATIONAL APPOINTMENTS AND PROMOTIONS

EFFECTIVE 1 AUGUST 2026

MAJORS WILSON AND BESNART CHIWOYA, officers of the Zambia Territory currently serving respectively as Secretary for Business Administration and Territorial Home League Secretary, in the Uganda Territory, are appointed as Chief Secretary and Territorial Secretary for Women's Ministries, Uganda Territory. They will take up their new appointment responsibilities with the rank of Lieut-Colonel. They will succeed Lieut-Colonels Emmanuel and Irene Sichibona who have been given medical leave.

EFFECTIVE 1 JANUARY 2027
